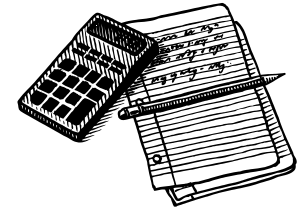




# EXAMS: USING CALCULATORS

For exam question papers where the use of calculators is allowed, **candidates are responsible for making sure that calculators meet the awarding bodies' regulations.**



*The instructions set out below apply to all examinations unless stated otherwise in an awarding bodies' subject-specific instructions.*

## Calculators must be:

- a suitable size;
- battery or solar powered;
- free of lids, cases & covers which have printed instructions or formulas

## Candidates are responsible for:

- the calculator's power supply;
- the calculator's working condition
- clearing anything stored in the calculator

## Calculators must **not**:

- be designed/adapted to have
  - × language translation;
  - × symbolic algebra manipulation;
  - × symbolic differentiation or integration
  - × communication facilities
- be borrowed from another candidate;
- have retrievable information stored in them – this includes:
  - databanks;
  - dictionaries;
  - mathematical formulas;
  - text
